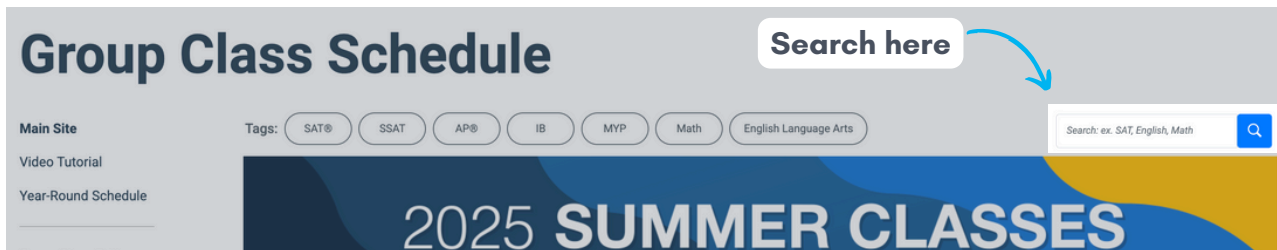
- **How should I select the appropriate grade-level class for my child?**
 - Your child should enroll in classes that correspond to the grade they will be entering in the fall. For example, if your child is currently in 6th grade but entering 7th grade in the fall, they should join the 7th/8th grade group classes.
- **What if I can't join Summer Classes until later in the summer? Will my child miss important class content if they don't start from Session 1?**
 - Each session has its own unique content, and later sessions do not require enrollment into prior sessions. You can join as many sessions as you like.
- **What is the cost of standard summer classes for high school students?**
 - Elementary and middle school classes are JPY 8,000 per hour, tax excluded.
- **What options are available if the class does not suit my child's academic level?**
 - If the class is too easy or too difficult, your child can switch to a different grade level class that provides the appropriate challenge, or they may opt for personalized instruction with a private tutor.
- **What does the **COMMITMENT-FREE GUARANTEE** entail?**
 - If you are not satisfied with your group class after the first day, you can withdraw free of charge and you will not be billed for that lesson. You can try as many classes as you want commitment-free.

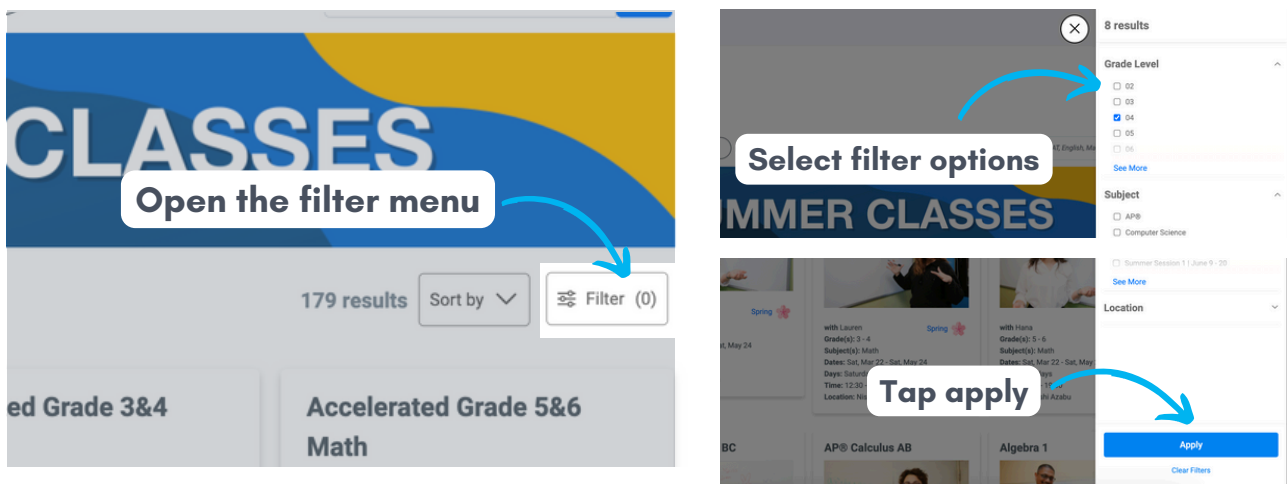
HOW TO USE THE GROUP CLASS PORTAL
